

Dahlgren Township April 13, 2026 Monthly Meeting

The Dahlgren Township Board of Supervisors met for a monthly meeting at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center on April 13, 2026. Chairman Thompson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

- Morgan Bock discussed the Township doing a Data Center Moratorium. She gave a background on data centers, i.e. water and electric consumption, noise generation, heat generation, etc. The Board stated that a moratorium was only good for one year and currently the Carver County Comp Plan is out to 2040 and the plans for the 2050 Comp Plan will begin later this year. The Township will continue to monitor any the changes to the Comp Plan. Topic has been tabled for now.

Craig Peterson:

- Craig discussed that the land surrounding him has been annexed into the City of Carver and there was a street going in directly behind his property. The Township stated that the Peterson's land would not be affected unless they chose to sell their property.

Road Report:

- Supervisor Kooiman received pricing for Dust Control On motion by Supervisor Kooiman and seconded by Chairman Thompson to use Quality Propane to apply the dust control and the price for residents will be the same as last year. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- Gravel Hauling: Art Johnson presented a quote for \$6.60 per ton from Bryan Rock and \$6.80 per ton from Chard Sibley Aggregate. On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Kooiman to accept the Art Johnson quote. Vote-aye-all-approved.
