The Dahlgren Township Board of Supervisors met for a monthly meeting at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center on February 10, 2025. • Sharon Siegle, representing Zoar Church, requested a variance for parcel split at the church property. Currently the cemetery, church and house are on one parcel and the parking lot is on a separate parcel. They would like a variance so that the cemetery was on one parcel and the church, house and parking lot was on a separate parcel. They potentially would like to sell the parcel with the church, house and parking lot and keep the cemetery, which would be maintained by the current congregation. The Board requested that the church provide to the Township a record and/or map of who is buried in the cemetery in case the cemetery would ever become the Township's responsibility. On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Gennrich to approve the variance, with the stipulation that the church provide the record and/or map of who is buried in the cemetery. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Cologne Fire Department:

• Chad Vos, Cologne Fire Chief, discussed an option that the Township would pay more than the current contract expense and that extra funds would be put into a savings account for to be used for future capital expenditures (i.e. firetrucks). For example, this year the Township would pay approximately \$49,000, if the Township chose to put some into the savings account, the amount would be approximately \$63,000. Also, the Department purchased a new tanker truck and the Township's portion of the truck is approximately \$95,000 due at the end of 2025. Chairman Thompson will contact the City of Cologne to see if the \$95,000 can be paid over a number of years to be determined. All of this will be discussed at the Annual Meeting.
