

MARCH 8, 2016

The Annual Town Meeting held for the Township of Dahlgren, in the County of Carver, and the State of Minnesota, at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center, 15180 Co. Rd. 40, Carver, MN. on this date, March 8, 2016 was called to order by Clerk Mary Olson at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Clerk Olson then called for a Moderator nominee, Todd Nelson was named Moderator.

First order of business: Minutes were typed and given out before the meeting and on request by township residents to dispense with the reading of the minutes.

The Financial report was given and on motion by Doran Brahee, seconded by Mark Willems to approve the report. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Fire Protection: On motion by Mark Willems and seconded by Corey Olson to continue with the City of Carver and the City of Cologne for fire protection. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Police Protection: On motion by Rich Buetow and seconded by Jim Abraham not hire any extra police protection. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Road and Bridge:

- Road repairs that were done in 2015 were discussed and also some of the projects planned for 2016.
- Dust control to stay at 1/3 coverage paid by Dahlgren Township and 2/3 coverage paid by the resident and applied twice during the summer. Dust control will also be applied on high traffic intersections within the Township, on motion by Art Buckentine and seconded by Dan Coleman. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Levy for 2017: On motion by Art Buckentine, seconded by Gene Miller to change the levy to \$175,000.00 for 2017. Motion failed 6 for and 9 opposed. On motion by Mark Willems and seconded by Steve Sommerville to change the levy to \$275,000 for 2017. Motion passed 14 for and 4 opposed. Motion carried.

Burning Permits will be available on-line and from Gene Miller and Mary Olson.

Official Newspapers will remain the same, The Chaska Herald and the Waconia Patriot.

The next Annual Meeting will be on the second Tuesday of March of 2016 (March 14, 2017), starting at 7:00 P.M. at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center. On motion by Corey Olson and seconded by Doran Brahee. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Township Picnic: On motion by Steve Sommerville and seconded by Doran Brahee that the Township has the approval to spend up to \$1000.00 on a Township picnic. Vote-aye-all-approved.


