

## MARCH 9, 2021

The Annual Town Meeting held for the Township of Dahlgren, in the County of Carver, and the State of Minnesota, at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center, 15180 Co. Rd. 40, Carver, MN, on this date, March 9, 2021 was called to order by Clerk Mary Olson at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Clerk Olson then called for a Moderator nominee, Theresa Mieseler was nominated as moderator.

First order of business: Minutes were typed and given out before the meeting and on request by township residents to dispense with the reading of the minutes. On motion by Mark Willems and seconded by Doran Brahee to approve the minutes as typed. Vote-aye-all-approve.

The Financial report was given and on motion by Jeff Thompson, seconded by Brian Gennrich to approve the report. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Fire Protection: On motion by Mark Willems and seconded by Mike Coleman to continue with the City of Carver and the City of Cologne for fire protection. Vote-aye-all-approved.

### Road and Bridge:

- 2020 road repairs – no comments
- 2021 road projects were discussed:
  - Dahlgren Road west of County Road 43 to Dahlgreen Golf Course – more patching and seal coating
  - Dahlgren Road west of Jonathan Carver Parkway to County Road 43 – the Township has applied for a Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) grant.

Levy for 2022: The motion was made by Mark Willems and seconded by Brian Gennrich to leave the levy at \$350,000 for 2022. Vote-aye-all-approved.

Burning Permits will be available on-line and from Gene Miller and Mary Olson.

The next Annual Meeting will be on the second Tuesday of March of 2022 (March 8, 2022), starting at 7:00 P.M. at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center.

### Other Business:

- The current General CD (\$33,242.76) was voted at a previous Township Annual Meeting to be used to build a new Town Hall. On motion by Jeff Thompson and seconded by Mark Willems that the money be not be earmarked for a new Town Hall and to be used as needed by the Township. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- Also, at a previous Township Annual Meeting, it was voted on to build a new Town Hall. On motion by Mark Willems and seconded by Jeff Thompson, that the Township reverses the authorization to build a new Town Hall, the Township will keep the 2.5 acres purchased for the a proposed new Town Hall. Vote-aye-all-approved.

There were 11 (including the Board) in attendance at the meeting.

On motion by Jeff Thompson, seconded by Doran Brahee to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
