

### **Dahlgren Township March 10, 2025 Monthly Meeting**

The Dahlgren Township Board of Supervisors met for a monthly meeting at the East Union Lutheran Church Parish Center on March 10, 2025. Present were Chairman Jeff Thompson, Supervisor Brian Gennrich, Supervisor Keith Kooiman, Clerk Mary Olson and Treasurer Doran Brahee. Also present was Ron Olson, Angie Maier, Mike Coleman, Adam Falkenstein, Julie & Randy Eiden and Dan Groen.

Chairman Thompson called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

The Township Meeting Minutes were typed and emailed out to Board Members. On Motion by Supervisor Kooiman and seconded by Supervisor Gennrich to approve the minutes. Vote-aye-all-approved.

#### **Augusta Ball Club:**

- Julie Eiden from the Augusta Ball Club requested a liquor license for the tournament being held at the Augusta Ball Park on May 30 – June 1, 2025 and a liquor license and a gambling license for the 52 Club drawing being held at the Augusta Ball Park on October 4, 2025. On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Gennrich to approve both liquor licenses and the gambling license. Vote-aye-all-approved.

#### **Road Report:**

- The Township received a quote from Bryan Rock for \$15.05/ton for ¾" red rock. On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Kooiman to accept the Bryan Rock quote. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- The Township received a quote from Art Johnson Trucking for hauling red rock of \$6.50/ton (an addition charge will be added if the Chaska and Jordan bridges are closed due to flooding). On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Kooiman to accept the quote from Art Johnson Trucking. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- Dust Control – two quotes were received for the dust control. Quality Propane quote was \$1.32/gallon, the other quote vendor did not offer magnesium chloride. On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Kooiman to accept the Quality Propane quote. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- Dust Control – The charge for residents will be \$1.10/ft for both applications. On motion by Chairman Thompson and seconded by Supervisor Kooiman to charge the residents \$1.10/ft for both applications. Vote-aye-all-approved.
- Mailbox replacement – on mailbox on Pine Cone Lane and one on Creekridge Lane.
