Rd. 40, Carver, MN, on this date, March 14, 2023 was called to order by Clerk Mary Olson at 7:00 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Clerk Olson then called for a Moderator nominee, Mark Willems was nominated as moderator.

First order of business: Minutes were typed and given out before the meeting and on request by township residents to dispense with the reading of the minutes. On motion by Doran Brahee and seconded by Keith Kooiman to approve the minutes as typed. Vote-aye-all-approve.

The Financial report was given and on motion by Corey Olson, seconded by Kerry Bement, to approve the report. Vote-aye-all-approved.

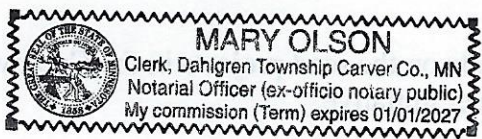
