RESOLUTION APPROVING STATE OF MINNESOTA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF DAHLGREN ON BEHALF OF ITS PROSECUTING ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, the Township of Dahlgren on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney desires to enter into Joint Powers Agreements with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to use systems and tools available over the State's criminal justice data communications network for which the Township is eligible. The Joint Powers Agreement further provide the Township with the ability to add, modify and delete connectivity, systems and tools over the five-year life of the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Board of Dahlgren, Minnesota as follows:

- 1. That the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements by and between the State of Minnesota acting through its Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the Township of Dahlgren, on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney, are hereby approved. Copies of the Joint Powers Agreement is attached to this Resolution and made a part of it.
- 2. That the County Attorney, Mark Metz, or his successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the Township's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.
- 3. That Jeff Thompson, the Board Chair for the Township of Dahlgren, and Mary Olson, the Township Clerk, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.
